How to make a claim

- 1 Go to hockey.honansport.com.au and lodge an incident report
- 2 Complete all relevant sections of the online application and submit with Sportscover directly.
- 3 Sportscover will respond within 48 hours of receipt of the claim and advise on next steps to be taken.

You can't claim if you...

- Play against medical advice
- Are under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Have a pre-existing injury
- Have a pre-existing illness or disease (i.e. cancer, heart condition)
- Are involved in a criminal act
