MASTERS INTRASTATE TOURNAMENT

RULES OF COMPETITION 2024

Age criteria for this year's Men's tournament is 34 or older in 2024, with Division One permitted to have a maximum of three players aged 32 or 33 in 2024.

Age criteria for this year's Women's tournament is 30 or older in 2024

1. Each Team Manager must enter their team onto the Match Sheet prior to the match (or hand a copy of their team list to the match manager to enter), indicating the starting team, captain for the match, goalkeepers, and the nominated coach for the match.
Players are not permitted to play in more than one team in the same division. If a team is reduced to 9 players or less, the Team Manager may seek dispensation from this rule from the Masters Committee.
2. Teams are not permitted to enter team benches until those involved in the previous match have vacated the area. Teams are to ensure they are on the correct team benches - the first named team will be on the bench to the left of the technical bench.
3. The first-named team is to provide the match ball.
4. There should be time available between matches for players to have a short warm up on the turf. Players, umpires, and match managers **must be ready to commence play at the scheduled start time.** The match manager will start the match clock at the scheduled time.
5. Each team captain is to wear a distinctive armband or similar distinguishing article on upper arm or shoulder or over the upper part of a sock for identification and be identified on the match sheet.
6. A team may consist of 11 named in the starting line-up, and up to 6 interchange field players (this may include injured players as long as no more than 6 field players are on the bench) + 1 kitted goalkeeper, and 4 team officials. **A player must have played at least two round robin matches to be eligible to play in a Finals match.**
7. All team personnel must remain on the team bench during play, except when a Team Manager is assisting with the interchange of players. Where dugouts have walls ensure that bench personnel remain behind the wall, and do not sit on the wall. The coach may stand outside the wall but must stay within one metre of the wall and must ensure to not impede the umpire.
8. **Duration of the game – two x 25 minutes halves with a five-minute half-time break.**
There will be no time out in this tournament. Please note on the Match Sheet if play is held up significantly due to injury or for any other reason.
9. **Points will be awarded as follows:**
 - For a **win** or a **forfeit** from an opposing team - **three** points.
 - For a **draw** - **one** point.
 - For a **loss** or **forfeit** to an opposing team - **no** points.
10. The Perpetual Trophy for each respective competition will be awarded to the team with the highest tally of points at the conclusion of competition. If two or more teams achieve the same highest tally the trophy will be shared between those teams.

THE EXAMINER CUP

Hockey Tasmania's annual masters tournament is hosted in Launceston each year.

It brings together nearly 200 hockey players from around Tasmania for a weekend tournament of "Fun, Fitness & Lifelong Friendships".

The Examiner Cup was first introduced in 1972 to acknowledge the winner of the annual THA State-wide Interclub Competition. With the cessation of this event in 1980, the Examiner Cup was then awarded to the overall winner of the Men's Veterans Intrastate Competition from 1983 - 2012.

Reintroducing this magnificent trophy to our Masters Intrastate Tournament in 2023, the **Examiner Cup is awarded to the Region with the highest total aggregate points** accumulated from participation in **Men's** Div 1 & Div 2, and **Women's** Serious & Social competitions. Each team plays four games over the two days of competition.

2024 Masters Hockey World Cups Cape Town and Auckland

The World Cup is the highest level competition played in Masters Hockey. In 2024 the Masters World Cups will be played over two venues, Cape Town South Africa 35+/ 40+/ 65+/ 70+/ 75+ and Auckland New Zealand 45+/ 50+ / 55+ / 60+

The Cape Town World Cups will be held 12-21 October 2024 and Auckland 7-16 November 2024. Men's Australian Representatives were selected from performances at the 2023 Nationals in Perth WA.
